## **Core vaccines (required)**

Vaccine:	Purpose:	When to immunize:
DAP/DHP	Vaccinates against canine distemper, adenovirus/hapatitis, parvovirus	<ul><li>6 to 8 weeks</li><li>10 to 12 weeks</li><li>14 to 16 weeks</li><li>Every 3 years</li></ul>
Rabies	Vaccinates against the fatal rabies virus and prevents the spread to humans and other mammals	<ul><li>14 to 16 weeks</li><li>Annually</li></ul>

## Non-core vaccines (optional)

Vaccine:	Purpose:	When to immunize:
Bordetella	Vaccinates against the bacteria Bordetella Bronchiseptica that may cause canine cough	<ul><li>6 to 8 weeks</li><li>Annually</li><li>As needed (often required when boarding a dog)</li></ul>
Canine influenza	Vaccinates against viral dog flu that may cause pneumonia or death	<ul><li>10 to 12 weeks</li><li>14 to 16 weeks</li><li>Annually</li></ul>
Leptospirosis	Vaccinates against Leptospira bacteria that may cause death and prevents spread to humans	<ul><li>10 to 12 weeks</li><li>14 to 16 weeks</li><li>Annually</li></ul>
Lyme	Vaccinates against Borrelia burgdorferi bacteria that is transmitted through tick bites	<ul><li>10 to 12 weeks</li><li>14 to 16 weeks</li><li>Annually</li></ul>
Parainfluenza	Vaccinates against the canine parainfluenza virus that commonly causes canine cough	• 6 to 8 weeks
