Core vaccines (required)

Vaccine:	Purpose:	When to immunize:
DAP/DHP	Vaccinates against canine distemper, adenovirus/hapatitis, parvovirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 6 to 8 weeks• 10 to 12 weeks• 14 to 16 weeks• Every 3 years
Rabies	Vaccinates against the fatal rabies virus and prevents the spread to humans and other mammals	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 14 to 16 weeks• Annually

Non-core vaccines (optional)

Vaccine:	Purpose:	When to immunize:
Bordetella	Vaccinates against the bacteria Bordetella Bronchiseptica that may cause canine cough	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 6 to 8 weeks• Annually• As needed (often required when boarding a dog)
Canine influenza	Vaccinates against viral dog flu that may cause pneumonia or death	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 10 to 12 weeks• 14 to 16 weeks• Annually
Leptospirosis	Vaccinates against Leptospira bacteria that may cause death and prevents spread to humans	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 10 to 12 weeks• 14 to 16 weeks• Annually
Lyme	Vaccinates against Borrelia burgdorferi bacteria that is transmitted through tick bites	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 10 to 12 weeks• 14 to 16 weeks• Annually
Parainfluenza	Vaccinates against the canine parainfluenza virus that commonly causes canine cough	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 6 to 8 weeks
